Thank you for your Freedom of Information request concerning unpaid bill for treating foreign nationals (non EU/EEA citizens).

The Trust can provide the following information:

I request disclosure of every unpaid bill for treating foreign nationals (non EU/EEA citizens) for the financial years 2012/2013 and 2013/14.

For each case I require:

the date of the treatment- **I can confirm this information we hold, however it is not in the format that it's being requested, and is estimated it would exceed 18 hours to collate the requested information and is exempt under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000**

the nature of the treatment- **see above (section 12 exemption)**

the nationality of the patient- **not recorded**

the sex of the patient- **see above (section 12 exemption)**

the age of the patient- **see above (section 12 exemption)**

the hospital where the treatment was carried out- **Homerton University Hospital Foundation Trust**

the amount the treatment cost (estimation is fine)

the amount of the treatment cost recovered by the hospital from the patient, if possible an indication of whether the remaining bill for treatment is still being actively sought or has been written-off

**Can provide an overall total cost and overall amount paid and overall current balance due**
