The average salary for a f/t female doctor is £50,511.32

5. How many full-time female nurses are employed at Homerton Hospital?

There are 848 full time female nurses employed at Homerton.

6. How many full-time male nurses are employed at Homerton Hospital?

There are 103 full time male nurses employed at Homerton

7. What is the average salary for a full-time female nurse?

The average salary for a f/t female nurse is £35,680.64

8. What is the average salary for a full-time male nurse?

The average salary for a f/t male nurse is £37,766.81
