	10 - 21 days	New Birth Visit	To see that mother and baby are well and to introduce The Healthy Child Programme	Health visitor	Carried out at home
	6 weeks	Development Review and BCG immunisation	To see that your baby is developing well and to protect against TB	GP or Community Paediatrician	GP Surgery or Child Health Clinic
	2 months	1st Primary Immunisation	5-in-1 vaccine, to protect children from diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough, polio and Haemophilus influenzae B (Hib) Vaccines to protect from pneumococcal disease, rotavirus infection and meningococcal B disease (MenB)	Practice Nurse	GP Surgery
	3 months	2nd Primary Immunisation	Second dose of the 5-in-1 vaccine, second dose of rotavirus vaccine and a vaccine to protect against meningococcal C disease (MenC)	Practice Nurse	GP Surgery
