Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information request regarding Homerton hospital A&E services.

The Trust can provide the following information:

- 1. How many minors/see & treat patients are seen in the A&E per day? If no statistics available please provide an approximate amount estimated by the Clinical Lead of the department - 21646 last year which equates to daily average 59.3**
- 2. How many haematology blood test requests are sent from the A&E? A&E sent 92,425 Haematology tests to pathology from April 15 to March 16.**
- 3. How many patients arrive to the A&E by ambulance? 18280 last year which equates to average 50 per day**
- 4. How many ENPs/ANPs does the A&E employ? 8 WTE**
- 5. Is the A&E paid by the CCG per patient according to the national tariff for type 1 A&Es? Are there any modifications to the tariff?** The majority of attendances are paid via the national tariff with the exception of City and Hackney CCG urgent care patients for which the Trust has a block contract.
- 6. How big is the activity with regards to particular HRG codes in minors area? For example how many patients with VB08Z code are seen annually? Please provide figures for all A&E HRG codes?** The Trust will not be able to provide the above information. This is because our contract monitoring shows minor and major A&E data together and also excludes the block contract that the Trust has with City and Hackney, regarding this type of activity.
