**1. How many Obstetrics and Gynecology ST3s within your Trust are transitioning onto the new *Terms and Conditions for NHS Doctors and Dentists in Training (England) 2016 on 5 October 2016* represented as –**

**a) The total number of Obstetrics and Gynecology ST3s transitioning – 8 doctors transitioning (1 ST3, 7 ST4+)**

**b) The total number as a percentage of Obstetrics and Gynecology ST3s transitioning - 100% of ST3+ doctors are transitioning**
